We were very proud to be selected to build (4) 22,500 carbon steel pressure vessels which act as a buffer mechanism between the compressor and the fluctuating pressure caused by the changing demand in pressures for the sphere in Las Vegas, NV.

With an auditorium that can seat 17,600 people with a standing room for 20,000 people, it is the world's largest spherical structure. Built using six million pounds of steel, the Sphere's dome alone weighs 13,000 tons and has a surface area of 220,000 square feet.
