We greatly improved our structural rolling capabilities by purchasing a 2014 Faccin bar & angle roll. This piece of equipment can roll angle (0.625"x6"x6"), pipe, tubing (.3125"x5"x5"), some channel, some beam, and flat bar. It is truly state of the art. We also purchased some other equipment that is specific to the tank industry (welders, electric rubber rolls, welding positioners). These industry specific pieces of equipment will help us build tanks with greater efficiency.
