35,000 Gallon Stainless Steel Pressure Vessel

In August the Kennedy Tank team fabricated and delivered this stainless vessel that was 11'-6" OD X 43' tangent to tangent length made of 316L stainless steel material. This vessel weighed 36,380 pounds and mainly comprised of 3/8" thick plate. This vessel also included multiple platforms and ladders, spot x-ray, and (19) nozzles. Heck of a job by the entire team and special shout out to Ryan Wheeler for his 3D engineered drawings and project management skills on this project!
