Thank you for reading the July edition of Kennedy Tank Talk. Read below for updates from the Kennedy Tank Team.

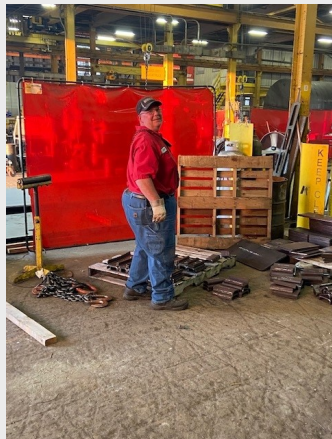
The team successfully fabricated this custom and large pressure vessel!
