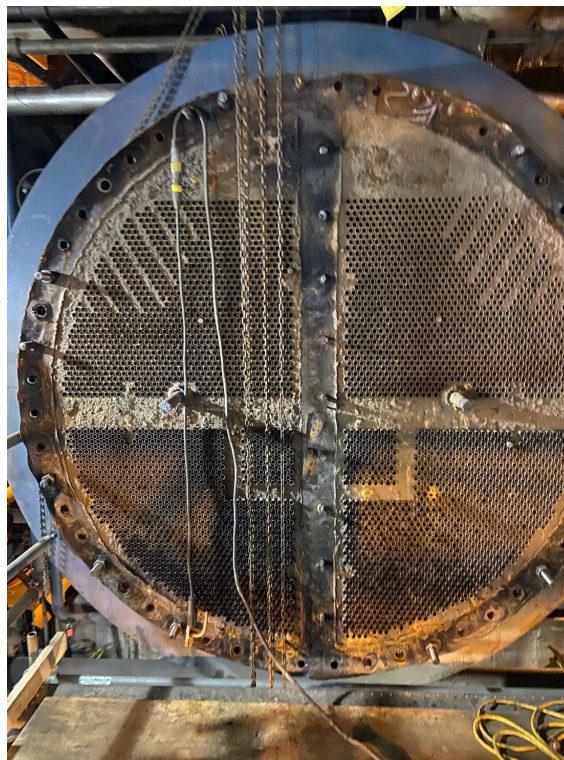


We welcome customers to come to visit our shop!
