Several Interesting Projects in Fabrication



We are mid-fabrication on (2) 14'-6" diameter X 34' long carbon steel water filtration tanks fitted with several internal and external stiffeners.



We also built this BEM 23-240 shell and tube heat exchanger that was comprised of 2205 duplex material for both the tubes and tube sheets.

These are being built in bay 5 which is our largest bay.

We have both thermal and mechanical engineering expertise for heat exchangers.

Heavy Wall PWHT Vessel Hits the Road
