Thank you for reading the January edition of Kennedy Tank Talk.

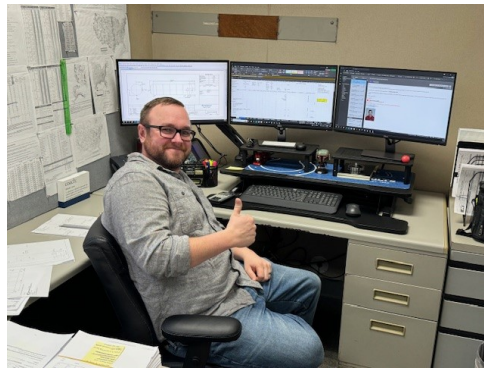
We are fired up for the new year and thankful for all of our teammates, customers, and vendors.
